Florida Association of Nurse Anesthesiology Elects New President and Board of Directors for 2025-2026

Orlando, Florida — The [Florida Association of Nurse Anesthesiology](#) (FANA) has announced its 2025-2026 President, leadership team, and newly elected Board of Directors. The new officers were sworn in during FANA's Annual Meeting in Orlando. FANA, Florida's 89-year-old professional association, represents more than 6,400 nurse anesthesiology professionals across the state.

Ryan Shores, DNP, CRNA, APRN, and Director of the University of North Florida Nurse Anesthesiology Program, will serve as FANA's President.

"Florida faces a critical health care workforce shortage, and CRNAs are an essential part of the solution," said Dr. Shores. "I am committed to working with lawmakers to modernize Florida's laws and remove outdated barriers — expanding patient access by allowing CRNAs to practice to the full extent of their education and training."

Dr. Shores was elected by the FANA membership and will serve a one-year term. Laura Molina, DNP, CRNA, will continue to serve as Immediate Past-President.
